The grouper fishing is so good now that the fisheries management folks have doubled what we're allowed to bring home.

But that's not all, the cobia, triple tail, bonito and black tip shark are also going on a rampage, which, at certain times during a charter, makes it hard to keep up so many fish on at the same time. It's general mayhem, but it's manageable. There's also been some very good fishing back in the calm waters of Sarasota Bay. Wolfmouth Charters clients have been limiting out on very nice red drum, black drum, bay grouper and flounder. I really like the size of the flounder we're getting this fall, and I'm also seeing some heavy pompano getting into the picture as well. We're blessed to have so many opportunities to enjoy world-class fishing right on our doorstep. I hope you set some time aside to see for yourself.
